### IE—Integrative Experience for Psychology

Psych 494PI, a 1-credit course entitled "Professional Development in Psychology", in combination with a psych 391\* seminar satisfies the IE requirement in Psychology; these courses do not need to be taken concurrently. The same 391\* seminar can be used for BOTH the seminar requirement and the IE requirement! Check your ARR for your options or speak with an advisor for more information.
